## GUIDELINES

1. Contact the Derrick Brooks Charities Youth Programs at (813) 241-1415 immediately to receive your orientation/enrollment location, date, and time. Orientation/Enrollment for is held every Monday at 5:00 PM. A parent/guardian must accompany new enrollees. Classes are held every Monday from 5:30 PM – 7:30 PM on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the George Edgecomb Courthouse, 800 East Twiggs.
2. Be on time. If you are late you may not be allowed to participate in the class.
3. **NO SHORTS of any kind including Capri pants, food, drinks or gum allowed. NO cell phones, hats, head scarves, bonnets, tank tops, basketball jerseys, tube tops, spaghetti strap tops or bare midriff shirts are allowed. Pants must be secured around the waist. No visible underwear. You will be denied entry into the building if you fail to comply.**
4. Always sign the roster! Credit will not be given if you don't sign the official roster.
5. Always bring a pen or pencil.
6. Parents must provide transportation home immediately after meetings.
7. You are required to attend a minimum of five (5) Monday classes and one (1) Teen Summit. Siblings and/or friends can enroll and attend with parent's permission. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend at least two (2) meetings: One (1) Monday class; and One (1) Parent Support Group held at the same time as the Teen Summit.

**EVERY CLASS BELOW MUST BE SIGNED AND DATED BY THE INSTRUCTOR. FAILURE TO COMPLETE ALL CLASSES CAN RESULT IN ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS OR PROSECUTION. ADDITIONAL CLASSES CAN BE COUNTED AS COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS WITH JPO/CASE MANAGER'S PRIOR APPROVAL.**
